What is the maximum height and density you would support for future buildings along Marine Drive corridor and Ambleside and Dundarave Villages?	-I support a thoughtful density approach through the corridor, heavily weighing the feedback and concerns brought about through the ongoing Ambleside Local Area Plan process. -It's not what I envision but a collaborative process to allow the right projects on the right sites to move forward, enshrine/respect existing liveability and the viability of small businesses/services.
9.	Traffic gridlock has been a major issue identified by residents. What actions would you take to address this issue? (50 words or less)	I have a three prong approach to working towards some overall and some tactical improvements for Traffic gridlock. -On demand Micro transit service to the Marine Drive mainline of Transit Routes that take you further while maintaining accessibility for Seniors and those with disabilities. -E-bike Low Interest Loan program for those that receive a property tax bill from the District. See Nelson BC. Not a cash subsidy! -Advocate the Province PLAN to replace the Ironworkers Bridge NOW!
